

Are there different types of benzodiazepines you like to use?

Dr. Dhossche:

Yes. Yes. I do use clonazepam. I also sometimes use the shorter-acting one as alprazolam — xanax. It's a bit different than ativan, but I've seen cases where ativan gives a partial response and I get something better with alprazolam, with xanax.

I do not keep them on such high dosages. Well, not like nobody, but there is some difference between benzos, which you can consider if lorazepam is not what you expect it to do, or you get some problems of side effects, or they do not seem to tolerate it, I try another benzo.
