

# **If a patient came in with possible catatonia, what symptoms would help you make that diagnosis?**

## **Dr. Carroll:**

There are certain things that patients with catatonia do that other patients do not do. And these are things that include waxy flexibility, they include echolalia, they include echopraxia.

There are 40 different catatonic signs, but there are some things that are just very specific to catatonia and not found in other conditions or help us to confirm the diagnosis.
