

What role do you think other medical diagnoses might play in catatonia?

Dr. Cuevas:

There are some important reviews about the prevalence of catatonia, and what the data studies say is that nearly 50 percent of catatonic clinical pictures are related to medical conditions, especially neurological conditions.

I really think that it should be one of our main areas of interest, especially in neurodegenerative disorders and autoimmune and encephalitis neurological disorders. But not only neurological disorders, also pathologies that could lead to a delirium state. Because I think that when there is a delirium state, it's easier to develop catatonic symptoms.
