Dr. Cuevas:

What we have done here in university is begin to introduce the theme of catatonia inside the program of medicine school in psychiatry. We didn't have any topics about catatonia. And we have decided to introduce catatonia, and even make seminars and practical experiences to make students aware that they are going to find it even if they are not doing psychiatry afterwards. That's the first step. I think it will be very important.

And then there is another thing that's to educational programs for residency doctors and also to the medical doctors, which is that they are not aware of this condition.
