



Are you involved in any studies on catatonia?

Dr. Cuevas:

Right now we are doing a study about delirium and catatonia, which is really interesting because you cannot diagnose the two syndromes at the same time — DSM-5 doesn't allow you to do that. And we really do believe that it could be all together. And we wanted to study this condition.

We are doing studies of the phenomenology of catatonia, meaning what are patients with catatonia experiencing? What are the feelings? What are they leaving at the moment that there is an acute catatonic state, and that's really interesting.

We are also studying cognition of catatonia. We are also studying biomarkers, trying to find any blood test or ECG markers that could improve the diagnosis of catatonia.
